

Chief Engineer

The position has the following direct responsibilities:

1. The engine department and the safety of the crew, machinery and environment directly within his control
2. The implementation of the Company's policies as contained within the Fleet Standing Instruction, company manuals and other official company instructions on all machinery related matters of operation, safety and environmental protection
3. The onboard discipline of all the engine department officers and crew and the appraisal of same
4. The safe operation of the vessel's machinery and technical plant
5. The monitoring of performance of the main propulsion and auxiliary machinery
6. The accurate monitoring and control of the vessel's fuel and lubricating oil consumption and the status of fuel and lubricating oil bunker quantities
7. The bunkering of fuel and lubricating oils and other fluids as appropriate
8. The maintenance and operation of tow winches, work winches, forks, shak jaws, spooling bear and pop up pins
9. The compliance statutory and classification survey requirements, with regards to machinery and relevant spaces
10. The accurate entry of all operational machinery parameters by the watch keepers/duty engineers in the engine room log
11. The reporting of any accident or damage to the vessel's machinery or technical plant
12. The safeguarding of the owner's and company's interest at all times
13. The undertaking of any other duties or instruction as required by the Company
